### Homework Challenge – Summer 1, 2024

We would like children to select at least one of the homework challenges below for this term, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading, maths and English homework that are set.

<p><b>Art – Freestanding structures</b></p> <p>Can you use some recyclable materials and some cardboard tubes to create a freestanding tower?</p> <p>How are you going to fix your materials together?</p>  <p>How tall can you get your structure to be before it collapses?</p>	<p><b>Science/English – Plants</b></p> <p>Can you create a fact sheet about looking after plants? Think about what plants need to survive and why we enjoy having them!</p> <p>Don't forget to add labelled pictures or diagrams to your poster.</p>  <p>Write in sentences with capital letters, full stops/exclamation marks or question marks.</p>	<p><b>Geography – Oceans and continents.</b></p> <p>Choose a continent.</p>  <p>Find out 5 facts about that continent. Write a sentence for each fact.</p> <p>You could find out: Where it is? What it is like to live there? Which oceans is it near? What animals live in the continent? What is the weather like? What is the land like (flat, hilly, snowy, hot and dry)?</p>
<p><b>Maths – Fractions</b></p> <p>Can you draw, make or bake something that can represent whole, half and quarters.</p> 	<p><b>RE – Is Shabbat important to Jewish children?</b></p> <p>Jewish people have a special day every week, they call it Shabbat. Write at least 3 sentences about the things that you have learnt about Shabbat.</p> 	<p><b>PSHE – Relationships</b></p> <p>How can we greet people? How might we greet a stranger? Your mum? Your teacher? A grandparent?</p>  <p>Act out meeting different people with your parents.</p> <p>Make a poster to show all the ways you can greet people (i.e., a smile, shake hands, bump elbows, hug, etc.)</p>

The challenge work is due in on **Friday 17<sup>th</sup> May** and on **Monday 20<sup>th</sup> May** each child will get to present their work for it to be celebrated. The above menu details a range of work for the subjects that your child will cover this term.
