English

In English this half term Year 4 will be learning to write an explanation text having studied the model text 'How a Jellyfish Stings'. Year 4 will develop an understanding of the key features needed to write an explanation text through the Talk 4 Writing method before writing their own.

The class text we will be reading this half term is 'Until I Met Dudley' by Roger McGough.

Year 4 will be consolidating aspects of Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar from the Year 4 curriculum.



Maths

In Maths this half term, Year 4 will begin looking at statistics, focusing on interpreting bar charts, pictograms and line graphs. We will then move onto position and direction introducing coordinates and exploring their positioning on a grid. Finally we will be looking at properties of shapes, with a focus on angles, turns and lines of symmetry. Lessons will include reasoning, problem solving and fluency skills. Maths will be taught through the mastery approach combining Maths No Problem and White Rose Maths. In lessons children will use a variety of resources to help them.

We will continue to work on arithmetic through daily sessions, as well as focusing on times tables.
