English

Summer 2

We will be beginning a block of work on 'Instructions' based on "How to Find Gold' by Viviane Schwarz

- Write a new set of instructions about a magical creature
- Write a diary entry from Anna's point of view

We will be learning new skills such as using:

- How to use adverbs
- Identify bossy verbs

We will then finish off with a block of work based on 'The Gruffalo' by Julia Donaldson.

- To write their own cumulative story
- To read/answer questions in relation to comprehension focus.

We will be learning new skills such as using:

- Prepositions- down, over, along, outside
- Alliteration- e.g. 'slithered slowly', green grass, paused patiently.
- Regular plural noun suffixes e.g. bags, friends, wings

Maths

Summer 2

Position and Direction - We will doing $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{3}{4}$ and full turns, both clockwise and anti-clockwise.

Place Value within 100 - include counting to 100 both forwards and backwards, using a 100 square, partitioning numbers, comparing and ordering numbers.

Money - recognising coins and notes and counting in coins.

Time - looking at before and after, time to the hour and half hour, writing time and comparing time. describing turn (quarter turn, half turn, three quarter turn and full turn) and describing position (left, right, above, below, forwards, backwards, etc).
