Year R: Term 6

English

We will continue to learn stories using actions and then retell them. We will be doing lots of writing, encouraging the children to work more independently. Stories will include 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff' by Pie Corbett.



Maths

We will be working on doubling and halving to start the half term. Then move on to elements of measure including height, weight and capacity. Children will explore this through practical activity and then follow up written activities.



Phonics

We will be following 'Read, Write Inc' as a method of learning our phonic sounds, and how to use them to read and write. Children are grouped by ability and work with other children who are the same level as themselves.
