PE is on a **Thursday**. Please make sure that children come to school dressed in full PE kit. If the weather is cold, tracksuits and trainers can be worn.

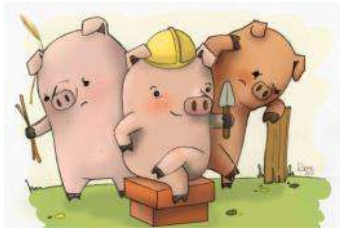

## English

We will be learning a new story using actions. We will create story maps of the events in the story and children will have a go at creating their own story maps and writing. The story we will explore is 'The Three Little Pigs' by Pie Corbett.

Children will have daily phonics sessions following Read Write inc. During these sessions we will learn to recognise letter sounds to help us to read and write words.



## Maths

We will use and explore the CBeebies programme 'Numberblocks' to teach the children an understanding of the numbers and the number system. We will be consolidating our knowledge of numbers 0-5.

Children will have opportunity to explore maths independently as well as in groups with an adult.



## Discover RE

We will be focusing on the topic of Christmas and thinking about the question; What is Christmas? This will involve exploring Christianity.

Children will have the opportunity to listen to stories, join in with discussions and complete activities based around weekly topics.
