Your child can continue to take home a story book from our Book Corner, which they can change as often as they like.


We hope you find the following information helpful in supporting your Child this half term.

English

We will be learning a new story using actions. We will create story maps of the events in the story and children will have a go at creating their own story maps and writing. The story we will explore is 'The Three Little Pigs' by Pie Corbett. Children will have daily phonics sessions following Read Write inc. During these sessions we will learn to recognise letter sounds to help us to read and write words.



Maths

We will use and explore the CBeebies programme 'Numberblocks' to teach the children an understanding of the numbers and the number system. We will be consolidating our knowledge of numbers 0-5, including adding and taking away. Children will have opportunity to explore maths independently as well as in groups with an adult.



Discover RE We will be focusing on the topic of Christmas and thinking about the question; What is Christmas? This will involve exploring Christianity. Children will have the opportunity to listen to stories, join in with discussions and complete activities based around weekly topics.
