### **English**

In English this half term, Year 3 will be learning to write an information text whilst learning the model text 'The Manchester Ridgeback' through Talk 4 Writing methods. Year 3 will develop an understanding of the key features needed in writing for an informative purpose before writing their own at the end of term. The class text we will be reading this term is The Land of Never Believe written by Norman Messenger.

In class, Year 3 will be continuing the RWINC spelling programme. Year 3 will be consolidating aspects of grammar this half term such as: fronted adverbials, punctuating direct speech, correct use of tense and clauses. Throughout the term we will continue to 'gap-fill' areas of teaching and learning that were missed. This will be done through assessment to inform teaching.



#### Maths

In Maths this half term, Year 3 will be extending their learning about multiplication and division. This will include: learning to multiply 2 and 1 digit numbers, dividing 2 and 1 digit numbers, comparing number statements as well as continuously developing times table knowledge. There are additional 'challenge' activities on hand each lesson to promote reasoning, problem solving and fluency skills. Maths will be taught through the mastery approach combining Maths No Problem and White Rose Maths.

In Year 3 your child will have daily mental arithmetic sessions along with a daily multiplication grid to practise their times tables.

In Maths throughout the term we will continue to 'gap-fill' areas of teaching and learning that were missed. This will be done through assessment to inform teaching.
