Class Information Year 4 Spring Term 2 2022

This half term we will teach the Year 4 curriculum, as well as continually assessing and filling in any gaps from the previous learning.

You will find a brief overview of the curriculum content for English and Maths as well as support for your child's well-being. Information about other subjects will be sent separately in a more detailed 'Knowledge Organiser'. This information is designed to give you a flavour of what the children in Year 4 will be learning this half term as well as some more detailed information on the knowledge we expect children to know at the end of this half term.

English

In English this half term, Year 4 will be learning to write a quest story having studied the model text 'Zelda Claw and the Rain Cat'. Year 4 will develop an understanding of the key features needed to write a quest story through the Talk 4 Writing method before writing their own.

The class text we will be reading this half term is 'Varjak Paw' by S. F Said.

In class, Year 4 will be using the Read Write Inc spellings programme to learn about spelling rules. For example words with the 'ay' sound spelt 'eigh, ei and ey' will be introduced. These spellings will be practised every day in school. Year 4 will be consolidating aspects of grammar from Year 3 as well as learning new content including personification and similes.



Maths

In Maths this half term, Year 4 will be introduced to fractions, focusing on counting, adding and subtracting fractions, finding equivalent fractions and finding fractions of amounts. We will then move on to looking at decimals where we will explore tenths and hundredths. Lessons will include reasoning, problem solving and fluency skills. Maths will be taught through the mastery approach combining Maths No Problem and White Rose Maths. In lessons children will use a variety of resources, such as 'place value grids', 'hundred squares' and 'base 10' to help them.

We will continue to work on arithmetic through daily sessions, as well as focusing on times tables.
