Class Information Year 2

Year 2: Autumn Term 1

English

In English for the first half of the term, your child will be learning about quest stories using a model text called 'The papaya that spoke'. Your child will learn about the toolkits needed to write a quest story, the layout and use the model text to help them write their own quest story. Alongside the model text, your child will also be reading 'Zeraffa Giraffa'.

In the second half of the term, your child will be learning about recounts using a model text called 'Local Hero Wins Medal'. Your child will learn about the toolkits needed to write a recount, the layout and use the model text to help them write their own recounts. In addition to the model text your child will also be reading 'Traction Man'.

In grammar lessons, we will be learning to use adjectives to describe an object (eg the fast, shiny car), similes (eg as fast as lightning) to add more detail and we will be continuing to consolidate the use capital letters and full stops.

To aid the children with their writing there will also be daily handwriting sessions.

Maths

In Maths this term, your child will be learning about place value, addition and subtraction. Within place value, your child will be using concrete apparatus such as Base 10 and Tens frames to aid them with their understanding of Ones, Tens and Hundreds. Once they are secure with this, your child will then represent these pictorially.

For addition and subtraction, your child will be taught using concrete methods to aid their understanding using Base 10, Numicon etc. Once they are secure with this, they will learn how to add and subtract pictorially. In every Maths lesson there are challenges available which are based on reasoning and problem solving.

Throughout the term, we will be practising mental arithmetic and times tables skills to keep our maths minds sharp!
