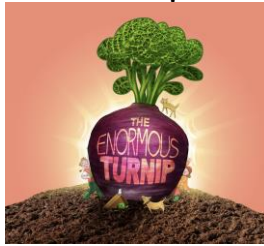

EYFS: Summer Term 1

English

We will be continuing to learn stories using actions in order to be able to retell them. We will create story maps of the events in each story and children will have a go at creating their own story maps and writing. This half term our story is The Enormous Turnip.



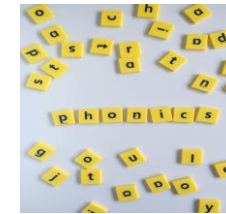
Maths

This half term we will be looking at making and exploring simple and more complex patterns. We will be looking at doubles, sharing equally and counting in 2's, 5's and 10's. We will also be counting on and back from different starting points.



Phonics

We will be following 'Read, Write Inc' as a method of learning our phonic sounds, and how to use them to read and write. Children are grouped by ability and work with other children who are the same level as themselves.
