Year 4: Autumn 2 2023

English

In English this half term, Year 4 will be learning to write a losing and finding tale, whilst learning the model text 'Adventure at Sandy Cove' through Talk 4 Writing methods. Year 4 will develop an understanding of the key features needed in writing a losing and finding tale before creating their own at the end of the term. The class text we will be reading this term is 'The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane' by Kate DiCamillo.

In class, Year 4 are focusing on the spelling of Year 3/4
Common Exception Words alongside some Year 4 Statutory
Spellings. We will also be continuing the RWINC spelling
programme. Year 4 will be consolidating aspects of grammar
this half term such as: differentiating pronouns and nouns,
using fronted adverbials in sentences, and modifying adjectives
and nouns. Throughout the term we will be 'gap-filling' to
consolidate prior learning.



Maths

In Maths this half term, Year 4 will be extending their learning about multiplication and division. This will include learning their 6,7,9-, 11- and 12-times table so please continue to practice these times tables at home with your child as this will help consolidate their learning ready for the multiplication check they will complete at the end of Year 4.

There are additional 'challenge' activities on hand each lesson to promote reasoning, problem solving and fluency skills. Maths will be taught through the mastery approach combining Maths No Problem and White Rose Maths.

In Year 4, your child will have daily mental arithmetic sessions along with a daily multiplication grid of their times table.

In Maths throughout the term, we will be 'gap-filling' areas of teaching and learning that were missed using assessment to inform teaching.
