Reading Books

Children are expected to read frequently at home, and this needs recording in their reading record book at least 3 times per week. We can't stress how important reading is in your child's reading, writing and spelling development.

PLEASE send your child's book bag and reading books to school. We really appreciate your help with this.

PE - On Wednesdays

For this half term, PE will be on a Wednesday afternoon. Please come to school on Wednesday in your PE kit. As it will be getting cooler, please ensure your child comes to school with a jumper or hoodie. PE kits must be a white top, dark joggers/shorts/leggings and trainers. No coloured tops please. Please can your child bring a named water bottle in each day. Hair must be tied up and earrings removed. Long hair must be tied back, and all earrings must be removed.

Homework

Homework will be set weekly on the Learning with Parents platform. Any issues accessing these please contact me.

English

We are finishing our work on Recount (work is based on the book *Mr Gumpy's outing*). Our next topic will then be Information Texts (work is based on 'Animals and their needs' and 'Wolves' by Emily Gravett).

We will be concentrating on spelling high frequency words (ie, the, at, in).

We will have daily phonics sessions.

We be making sure that we leave spaces between our words and write on the lines.

We are aiming to write simple sentences that have a full stop and capital letter and make sense.

We will be using adjectives (smelly, red, hot) and connectives (but, and, because) in our sentences.

Maths

We will finish off Addition and Subtraction within 10. We will be looking at how a number can be partitioned into two or more parts, which will help with number bonds, addition and subtraction.

We will then move on to 2D and 3D shape. We will be naming shapes and describing their properties.

Please encourage your child to find 2D shapes (triangles, circles, squares etc) and count how many sides, corners/vertices they have?

Can they name 3D shapes (ie, cuboid, cylinder, etc) and name the 2d shapes they can see? How many faces, edges and vertices/corners they can see?

We will move on to place Value within 20. To read, write and count up to 20. To count up to and back from 20.
