# English

In English this half term, Year 5 will be learning to write a Journey Tale whilst learning the model text 'The Forest' through Talk 4 Writing methods. Year 5 will develop an understanding of the key features needed to write a journey tale, before writing their own. The class text we will be reading this half term is 'The Journey' by Francesca Sanna.

In class, Year 5 are focussing on weekly RWINc Spelling Units as well as some Year 5 Statutory Spellings. Year 5 will be consolidating aspects of previously learnt grammar this half term before developing further knowledge with apostrophe use, verb tenses and sentence types.



## Maths

In Maths this half term, Year 5 will be learning Multiplication and Division. This will include: methods of multiplication and division, understanding factors, prime numbers as well as square/cube numbers. We will then move onto Fractions, which will include: understanding equivalent fractions, adding and subtracting fractions and understanding and converting improper fractions and mixed numbers. There are additional challenge activities on hand each lesson to promote reasoning, problem solving and fluency skills. Maths will be taught through the mastery approach with White Rose Maths.

In Year 5 your child will have daily mental arithmetic sessions as well as gap fill sessions.
