## <u>Homework Challenge - Spring Term 1 2025</u>

We would like children to select at least one of the homework challenges below for this term, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading, spellings, maths and English homework that are set.

#### D.T - Self portraits

Draw a portrait. What materials will you use? What style will you create it in? What colours will you use?

Draw a self-portrait or a portrait of a member of your family. You could create your art work in the style of a Picasso portrait.

#### Computing - Pictograms

Explore your family's favourite colour/food. What chocolate is their favourite? What was the most and least popular choice.

You could create a pictogram to display your data, then write sentences explaining what your data shows.

#### Science - The human body

Create an information leaflet about the human body. Which system will you write about? What images will you include?

Research a system within the body (digestive for example), use the information you find out to create a leaflet. You could also carry out an experiment or re-create your chosen system in 3D!

#### R.E - Mosques

Research and draw a Mosque. What features do they all have? What would you expect to see inside?
Research a Mosque maybe a famous
Mosque from another country. Draw and label it.

#### Geography - The British Isles

Plan a holiday to a country in the British Isles. Where will you go? How will you get there? What will you visit whilst you are there?

Get your holiday hat on, and plan a holiday to a country in the British Isles. Think of how you're going to get there and the places you could visit whilst you're there. You could ever write a post card / create a souvenir too.

#### PSHE - Dreams and Goals

Design your own dream jar. What do you dream of? What do you want to achieve?

Design or make your own dream jar (just like in The BFG). You could write your dreams on post-its to stick on your jars or use an actual jar, decorate it and pop your dreams.
