

Homework Challenge - Spring 1 2025

We would like children to select at least one of the homework challenges below for this term, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading, maths and English homework that are set.

DT - Food Technology Design a heathy soup, sandwich or smoothie.  Plan what you are going to put in it. Prepare all the ingredients that you will be using (i.e., Chop, grate, mash, spread). Take photos to show you preparing, making and eating your own food.	Science - Seasons and weather  Make a weather wheel. Use it to help you record the weather for a week.	Geography - The United Kingdom.  Can you find the United Kingdom on a globe or a map. Print out/ draw a blank map of the United Kingdom. Can you name, locate and identify characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding seas.
RE - Trust and Happiness Create a list of rules on how to live a happy and healthy life.  What can people do to be happy? E.g Go outside, play games with their friends, eat their favourite foods.	Read a 'Warning Story' - A warning story is a story where someone is told something important, but they ignore it! (like 'The 3 little pigs' and 'Little Red Riding Hood'). See if you can make some puppets and retell the story. Video yourself retelling the story. 	Maths - Challenge yourself to count up to and back from 50. Can you write all the numbers up to 50? Can you count in 10's up to 50? Can you count in 5's up to 50? Can you count in 2's up to 50? Can you practice your 2,5 and 10 times tables?

The challenge work is due in on **Friday 7th February**. You will be invited to see the homework challenges on **Monday 10th February**.
