### Homework Challenge – Autumn Term 2 2021

We would like children to select at least one of the homework challenges below for this term, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading, spellings, maths and English homework that are set.

<p><b><u>PSHE – Celebrating Difference</u></b></p> <p><b>Create you!</b> What do you like about you? What can you do? What makes you unique?</p> <p>Explore what it means to be unique. You can create yourself in whatever for you'd like to. Celebrate the things that make you, you! You can be as creative as you like.</p>	<p><b><u>Science – Living things and their habitats</u></b></p> <p><b>Investigate and create a leaflet on how to protect habitats.</b> Which habitat will you choose? How could we protect it?</p> <p>Investigate a habitat of your choice and research how humans could keep this habitat safe. For example you could choose to create a leaflet on 'Protecting Rainforests' and write about how deforestation is damaging many animals' habitats and how we can protect them.</p>	<p><b><u>History – Stone Age to the Iron Age</u></b></p> <p><b>Create a 3D version of Stonehenge.</b> What materials would you use? What colours would you choose?</p> <p>Create your own version of Stonehenge, you could use materials like cardboard or even try baking. Research what Stonehenge represented and how it is still a mystery today.</p>
<p><b><u>R.E – Christmas Celebrations</u></b></p> <p><b>Explore Christmas traditions from around the world.</b> How do other countries celebrate Christmas? What are the similarities and differences?</p> <p>You could create a fact file about how another country celebrates Christmas or you could make something that they create especially for Christmas. It is up to you how you wish to present this information.</p>	<p><b><u>English – Recounts</u></b></p> <p><b>Write a recount of an adventure or fun trip that you have been on.</b> Where did you go? What activities did you do? Who went with you?</p> <p>Write a recount about a real or imaginary adventure you have been on. You could choose to write your recount as a newspaper report or as a diary entry for example. Remember to tell us who you went with, what you got up to and how you felt.</p>	<p><b><u>Art &amp; D.T – Mechanisms and Levers</u></b></p> <p><b>Create a moving Christmas card.</b> How will it move? What part of the card will be the moving part?</p> <p>Create a moving Christmas card - It is up to you to choose the materials, colours and shapes you wish to use. Get imaginative and see what artwork you can create. You could even send your made Christmas card to some special.</p>
