### Homework Challenge - Summer 2, 2021

We would like children to select at least one of the homework challenges below for this term; however, children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading, spellings and maths homework that are set.

<p><b>Art - Sculpture</b></p> <p>Use materials that you have at home to create a sculpture. You might use tin foil or paper in your house, or maybe materials from outdoors like sticks and stones! Be creative and take photos of your sculpture.</p> 	<p><b>Science - Magnets and Materials</b></p> <p>Find out the different ways magnets are used in our everyday lives. You may be surprised by the different things magnets are hidden in to work! Use photographs, drawings and / or writing to share your research.</p> 	<p><b>History - Prehistoric Britain</b></p> <p>Research more into what life was like during either the ice age, stone age, bronze age or iron age. Compare it to your life today - what differences are there? Think of what you eat, where you live and what you like to do.</p> 
<p><b>English</b></p> <p>Keep a log of the books you enjoy reading. You might take photos of the books and you reading them, you might write a review or choose your favourite book to write and draw pictures about.</p> 	<p><b>Music - Being Imaginative</b></p> <p>Can you create a performance to your favourite piece of music? Think about what you will wear and how you will move to express the music. Film or take photographs of your performance.</p> 	<p><b>PSHE - Changing Me</b></p> <p>Look at photographs of you and members of your family when you were a baby and / or young child. How have you changed? What changes have happened in your life, for example moving house or getting a baby sibling?</p> 

The challenge work is due in **Monday 12<sup>th</sup> July** and we will have our homework challenge showcase where the children's hard work can be celebrated with the rest of the class. The above menu details a range of work for the subjects that your child will cover this term.

The children have their 'Homework Challenge book' to record their homework in if they wish. However, depending on the option they choose, the children may choose to record their homework in a different way that doesn't involve using their homework book.

We do ask that everyone has a go at this homework, so they all have something to share at the end of each term. We thank you for your continued support and look forward to seeing the children's fantastic work.
