


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Year 2 Homework Challenge – Summer Term 1 2024

We would like children to select at least one of the homework challenges below for this term, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading, spellings, maths and English homework that are set.

<p><u>Mural</u></p> <p>Can you design a mural that you would like on one of the walls in your bedroom?</p> 	<p><u>Scientists</u></p> <p>Research a famous scientist who created an important electrical invention and present your findings (e.g. Edison, Faraday, Franklin).</p> 	<p><u>Northern Europe</u></p> <p>Choose one of the Scandinavian or Nordic countries and create a display including key information, landscape, currency, landmarks, climate etc.</p> 
<p><u>Survey</u></p> <p>Create a survey of your family/friends favourite... Present it in either a bar graph or as a pictogram.</p> 	<p><u>R.E – Islam</u></p> <p>Research and draw a mosque. <i>What does a mosque look like? What are they like on the inside? What happens in a mosque?</i></p> <p>Get creative draw an image of a mosque, you can then add information that you have found out about a mosque to your image.</p> 	<p><u>PSHE – Relationships</u></p> <p>Write a card to someone special. <i>Who will you choose to write a card to? Why is this person special to you? How do they make you feel?</i></p> <p>Create and write a card to someone special to let them know what they mean to you. You can choose anyone you like. See if they decide to write a card / message back to you.</p>
