Homework Challenge - Autumn Term 2, 2023

We would like children to select at least one of the homework challenges below for this term, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading, maths and English homework that are set.

<p><u>English - Recounts</u></p> <p>Write a recount of an adventure or fun trip that you have been on. <i>Where did you go? What activities did you do? Who went with you?</i></p> <p>Write a recount about a real or imaginary adventure you have been on. You could choose to write your recount as a newspaper report or as a diary entry for example.</p> <p>Remember to tell us who you went with, what you got up to and how you felt.</p>	<p><u>Science - Ocean habitat</u></p> <p>Create a factfile or information board all about ocean habitats including the deep ocean. Think about what animals live there, how they are adapted to live there and any other interesting facts!</p> 	<p><u>PSHE - Celebrating Difference</u></p> <p>Create you! What do you like about you? What can you do? What makes you unique?</p> <p>Explore what it means to be unique. You can create yourself in whatever for you'd like to.</p> <p>Celebrate the things that make you, you! You can be as creative as you like.</p> 
<p><u>DT/Reading</u></p> <p>Can you visit the local library or look at books at home which have moving parts. How do they move?</p> 	<p><u>RE - Nativity</u></p> <p>Can you create a 3D Nativity scene? Think about who you will place in the scene and what materials you will use.</p> 	<p><u>History - Stone Age to Iron Age</u></p> <p>Can you create a cave painting?</p> <p>What materials can you use to draw the pictures? What symbols/pictures will you draw?</p> <p>Think about what life was like at the time.</p> 

The challenge work is due in on **Monday 11th December**. We will then invite parents/carers into class on the **15th December** for you to be able to watch your child present their homework to the class.
