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Year 2 Homework Challenge – Autumn Term 1 2025

We would like children to select at least one of the homework challenges below for this term, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular weekly homework.

<u>Geography – Spatial Sense</u> Draw a map of your local area. Do you live near a park or shop? Are you close to school? Who lives near you? Remember to include a key. Think about the symbols you choose to represent houses, shops, parks, churches, fields etc. <i>My Local Area</i> 	<u>Science – Living things and their habitats</u> Investigate and create a habitat. What animals live in your chosen habitat? What does the habitat look like? How have the animals and plants adapted to live there? 	<u>Computing – Online safety and IT around us</u> Create a poster of your choice explaining either 'How to be safe online' or about your favourite use of IT. Remember to make your posters colourful and eye-catching. 
<u>PSHE – Being Me</u> Create a fact file about yourself. How old are you? What is your appearance? What is your favourite food, hobby etc? Who is in your family? 	<u>R.E – What did Jesus teach?</u> Carry out acts of kindness. What could you do to help someone? How would they feel afterwards? See how many acts of kindness you can do this term. 	<u>Art – Colour and Shape</u> Create an image using a variety of colours and shapes. Notice what happens when you mix two colours together. Try and only use the primary and secondary colours. 

The challenge work is due in **Friday 17th October** and on **Monday 20th October at 2:55pm** each child will get to present their work and for it to be celebrated. Parents are invited to this session too! The above menu details a range of work for the subjects that your child will cover this term.
