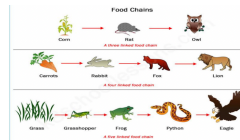

English – Portal Story Write your own portal story Write your own portal story using our portal toolkits for writing. What is the name of your setting? Who is your main character? How were they feeling? 	PSHE – Being Me In My World Create your own learning charter Make your own learning charter about what you would like to achieve by the end of Year 4. What are you going to need to do to achieve that? E.g., good listening, always trying my best. 	Science – Classification of Animals Create a fact file all about your favourite animal! Using your knowledge organiser and key vocabulary, create an animal fact file about your favourite animal. Is it an invertebrate? Is it warm or cold blooded? Where would I find your animal on a food chain? Include a mixture of writing and pictures/diagrams to share with the class. 
History – Anglo Saxons, Vikings and Scots Build your own Anglo-Saxon house! Create your own Anglo-Saxon house using a cardboard box as the base structure, add lollipop sticks for the wooden planks and wool or straw for the roof. Take a photo or bring it into school 😊 	Art – Still Life Create your own still life drawing Choose a mixture of objects from home and set them up together. Using a pencil, sketch them focusing on all the techniques we have been learning about. Think about the tone and shade as well. If you want to challenge yourself, label the shadow, highlights and mid-tone! 	Maths – Times Table Quiz Put your times-table knowledge to the test! Get a family member or friend to test you on your times table knowledge! It could be the 3's, 8's, and 4's whichever ones you need help on. Challenge yourself and be tested on a mixture, put a timer on and see how many you get correct in a minute!
