







**Year 3****Homework Challenge Menu Autumn 2 2025**

<p><u>History - Ancient Greece</u></p>  <p>Create a fact file about Ancient Greece. Or link to our 'persuasive text' unit and write a brochure about visiting Ancient Greek monuments!</p>	<p><u>Science - Water cycle</u></p>  <p>Create a diagram to show the water cycle. Add labels and any extra information to explain your diagram.</p>	<p><u>Geography - Western Europe</u></p>  <p>Create a piece of artwork (2D or maybe even 3D) to represent one of our Western European countries: France, Germany, Belgium, Switzerland, the Netherlands or Austria.</p>
<p><u>R.E. - Christmas</u></p>  <p>Why is Christmas special for many? If you celebrate Christmas, you can write about (or creatively show) how your family celebrates.</p>	<p><u>D.T. - Textiles</u></p>  <p>Design an outfit or accessory for yourself or someone you know. Can you label its key features?</p>	<p><u>PSHE - Celebrating Difference</u></p>  <p>Choose a friend or family member and write about how you are different.</p>
