


Create drawings of some and explain their significance.</p> 	<p>Art - Italian renaissance</p> <p>Create a display or overview showing some of the famous artworks and artists from this period with a brief description of each piece.</p> 	<p>PSHE - Celebrating difference</p> <p>Create a poster promoting the importance of celebrating differences.</p>
