English

In English this half term, Year 5 will be learning to write an explanation text. This will be done through learning the model text 'Why Trolls are Dangerous' through the Talk 4 Writing method.

Year 5 will develop an understanding of the key features needed in writing an explanation text and then apply these skills to their own writing. The class text we will be reading this half term is 'Wolf Brother' by Michelle Paver.

In class, Year 5 will be focusing on weekly RWI Spelling Units, Year 5 Statutory Spellings and handwriting. Year 5 will be consolidating aspects of previously learnt grammar and developing further knowledge with clauses, nouns and sentence structure. Throughout the term, we will continue to 'gap-fill' areas of teaching and learning.

Can you please help your child is to learn their year 3/4 and 5/6 spelling words at home to help with their English skills.



Maths

In Maths this half term, Year 5 will be learning Place Value, Addition & Subtraction, Multiplication & Division and Fractions. This will include understanding roman numerals, understanding place value of numbers up to one million and rounding numbers. There are additional challenge activities each lesson to promote reasoning, problem solving and fluency skills. Maths will be taught through the mastery approach with White Rose Maths.

In Year 5 your child will have daily mental arithmetic sessions, gap fill sessions and times tables practice.

In Maths throughout the term we will continue to 'gap-fill' any areas of teaching and learning necessary.

Can you please help your child to regularly revisit their times tables to ensure fluidity and increase their recall time.
