English

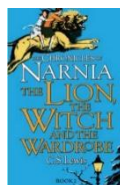
Narrative - Journey Tale

The children will be engaging with varied writing styles and learning the features of them. They will have weekly opportunities for short-burst creative writing based on what we are focussing on that week.

Full punctuation for direct speech

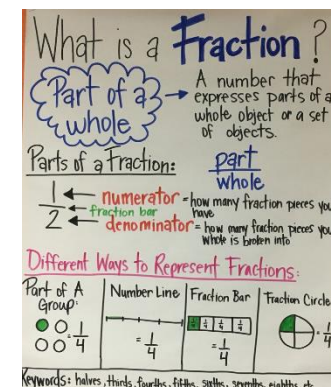


Maths

This half term we will be concentrating on **fractions** and **multiplication and division**.

Fractions will cover:

- Exploring equivalent fractions
- Converting proper mixed number fractions
- Comparing and ordering fractions
- Adding and subtracting fractions.



Multiplication and division will cover:

- Using column method for multiplying two numbers together (up to 4-digit x 2-digit)
- Short division (up to 4-digit by 1-digit)
- Dividing with remainders
- Efficient division
