PE - will continue to be on a Thursday

PE kit can be worn to school on a Thursday. Children need to wear PE kit as per the school prospectus; navy or black skort/shorts/jogging bottoms, white t-shirt and trainers/plimsolls.

Water bottles and snack

Year R: Term 2

English

This half term we will continue to rehearse our oral story telling skills through our new story 'The three little pigs' by Pie Corbett. Children will have the opportunity to write, draw and discuss the events, characters and settings.

Phonics

We will continue to have daily phonics sessions.

Within these sessions the children will be segmenting, blending and reading an increasing number of words using the sounds previously taught.



Discovery RE

We will be focusing on the topic of Christmas and thinking about the question; What is Christmas? This will involve exploring Christianity.

Children will have the opportunity to listen to stories, join in with discussions and complete activities based around the weekly topics.



Maths

We will continue to focus on numbers 0-5. We will look specifically at number bonds, adding one more and subtracting one less.

Children will have lots of opportunity to explore number through independent investigation as well as in guided groups with an adult.
