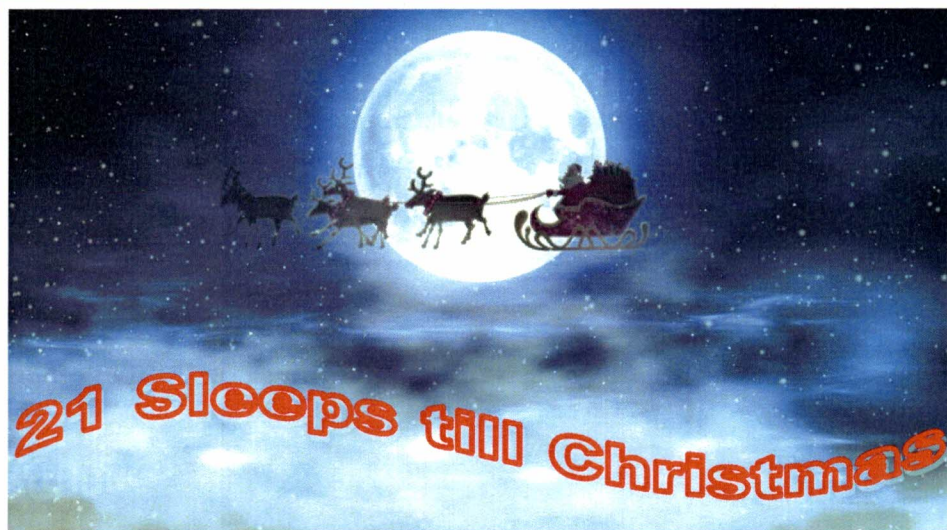

The books aimed at all primary ages explore the dangers to our ocean wildlife from the plastics and other wastes left in the seas.

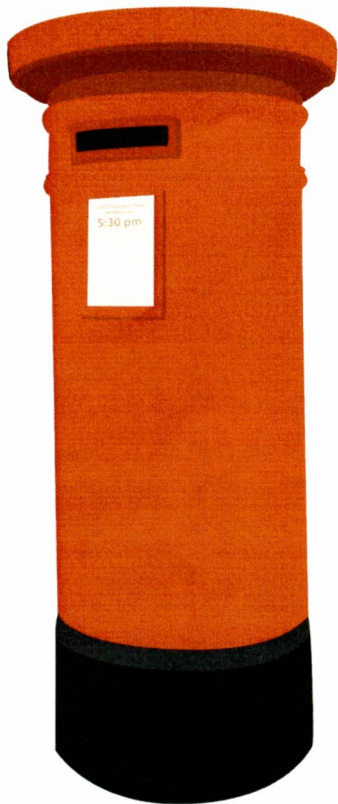

Year 6 making money for the NHS

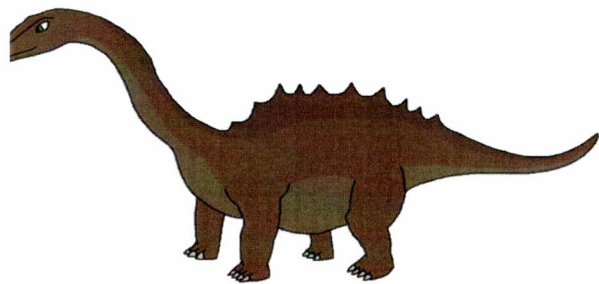
