As you can, Class 4 were spellbound by the artifacts and sights of the Stories of Lynn on Wednesday.....

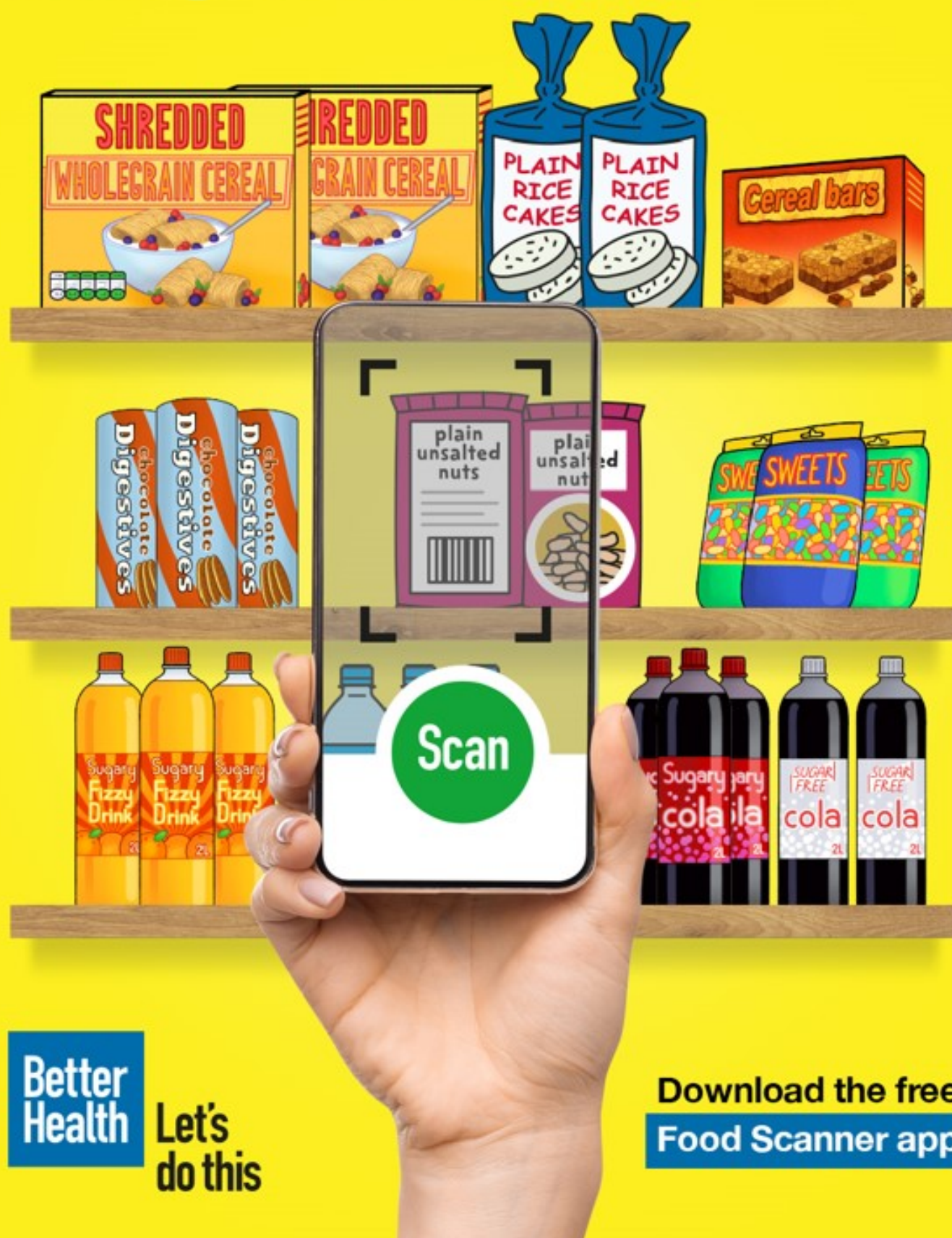


They managed to learn lots about Charles I and the siege of King's Lynn.
