Making the most of your leftovers!

- Now more than ever, it is important to make sure you are getting the most out of your food! We have been sent some ideas from the "Kids Fruit" organisation that we thought might be useful to share. Look out for the next one, next week!
- Fruit Smoothies and Juices

CALLING ALL

- There is nothing better than a fruit smoothie to quench your thirst. They are absolutely delicious and they fill you up too, to stop you from getting hungry in between your meals!
- When your fruit is looking a little over-ripe, make sure your give it a wash, peel and chop it up before putting it in the blender. Then add some liquid to thin it out - we recommend yoghurt with a bit of milk for a more filling smoothie, or some fruit juice (you can use water if you do not have any) and some ice for a more refreshing drink.
- You can try many different combinations of fruit (or sometimes even vegetables) that you want! Sometimes we even add spreads or oats for extra flavour!
- Our favourite breakfast smoothie is: one banana, a dollop of peanut butter, half a cup of oat milk, some crushed ice and a drizzle of honey. Give it a try, we promise it is delicious (Being careful of allergens of course).
- If you make too much, you can always put it in the freezer and save it for another day, or eat it as a frozen dessert (this works best for yogurt-based smoothies)
