Tips for Reading!

Hint number three!

Read out loud! This is important to do in normal times, but now everyone is unsettled this kind of personal together is particularly excellent way of comforting your child. Making the most of your leftovers!

This week - Brussel Sprouts Bubble and Squeak Cakes!

This recipe is a healthy, seasonal twist on the old Bubble and Squeak classic. Bubble and Squeak is one of our favourite recipes and often reminds us of being children. The best thing about this is it is really quick and simple! You can even put your own twist on it, depending on what vegetables you have leftover from the week.

Ingredients:

- 400g of leftover mashed potato
- 200g of leftover
- Black Pepper
- Mixed dried Herbs

1. Preheat oven to 200°C/Gas Mark 6
2. Line a baking tray with baking paper
3. Mash the Brussel sprouts with the mashed potato. The mixture should be chunky but hold together when you shape it into cakes. You can use a food processor for a few seconds but be careful not to make the mixture too smooth.
4. Add the black pepper to taste and a sprinkle of mixed herbs if using.
5. Take a handful of mixture and roll into a ball. Put in on a tray and flatten it into a cake shape with the palm of your hand.
6. Bake for 25-30 minutes until they are golden brown. Cooking time will vary depending on size of the cakes. To ensure even crispiness, turn over the cakes 5 minutes before the end of cooking to cook the underside.
7. Serve with salad, baked beans, leftover cold meats or seasonal vegetables.

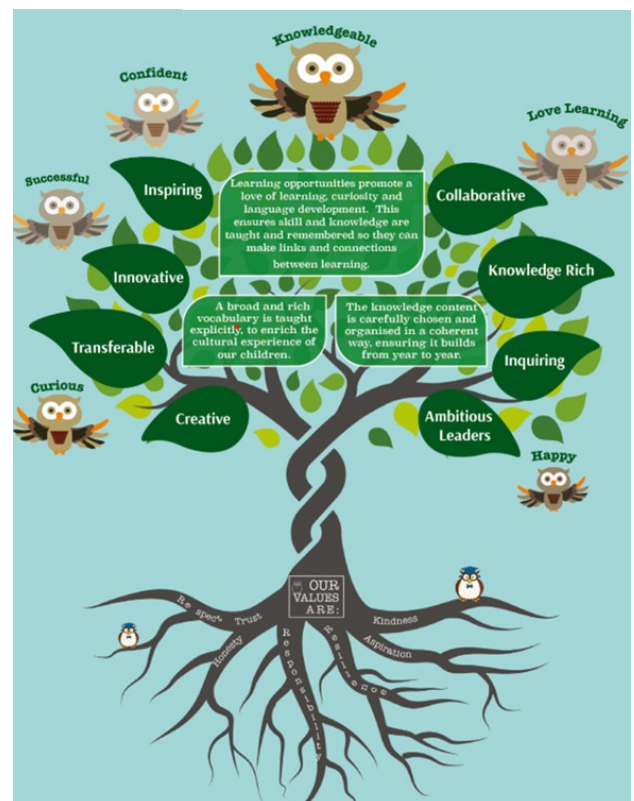
