PUMPKIN MUFFINS!

Ingredients

- 225g plain flour
- 2 tsp baking powder
- 1 tbsp ground cinnamon (or 2 tsp pumpkin spice)
- 100g caster sugar
- 50g soft light brown sugar
- 200g pumpkin purée (from last week's recipe!)
- 2 large eggs
- 125g slightly salted butter, melted

<u>Step 1</u>

Heat the oven to 200C/180C fan/gas 6. Line a 12-hole muffin tin with muffin cases. Mix the flour, baking powder, cinnamon and both sugars together in a large <u>bowl</u>. Break up any lumps of brown sugar by rubbing them between your fingers

<u>Step 2</u>

<u>Whisk</u> the purée and eggs together in a jug, then add to the dry ingredients with the melted butter. Whisk for 1-2 mins with an electric hand whisk until just combined.

<u>Step 3</u>

Bake for 15 mins until golden and risen and a skewer inserted comes out clean. Lift onto a <u>wire</u> rack to cool completely. *Will keep for three days in an airtight container*.
