They will speak with members of an Iceni tribe and find out how they feel about their defeated hero - Boudicca. They will hear about life under the rule of the Romans.

Not only will the children get the opportunity to handle replicas and some real roman artefacts, they will also get to make their own torc. This dip into history will give a very real look into how Boudicca's people held onto her vision of "Warrior Queen", even in death, and also how the Romans influenced and changed a nation.
