Internet Safety

We have become increasingly aware of highly inappropriate videos circulating online that are being viewed by children. These clips are appearing on many social media sites, Fortnite and You Tube, including Kids You Tube.

These videos contain extremely distressing images or highly inappropriate, dangerous "challenges" aimed at young children.

We would encourage you to be extra vigilant when your child is using any device or watching any clips. We would also encourage any parents / carers to remind children how to stay safe online: if they see anything which they find upsetting, they must tell an adult straight away.

This week in school we have added extra Internet Safety sessions to the curriculum.


