Remembrance Performance

I was lucky enough to be invited to the Remembrance Performance held at Springwood High School. Yesterday, I was at the wreath laying at Tower Gardens followed by the Remembrance Day service at the Minster and later in the evening at the lighting of the beacon but tonight's concert was more moving and full of pathos excellently performed by KS2 children from the Trust Primary schools including, West Lynn, Clenchwarton and Walpole Cross Keys. I can't tell you how proud of them I was as were the parents I talked to afterwards. Other guests were also talking about it and complimenting the children. I can tell you I was glad I had a hankie with me.

My grandfather served in World War I. He was gassed and I've only just found out recently that his cousin who was awarded the Military Cross was killed in March 1918, just a few months before Armistice. My father served in World War 2 and was a prisoner of war in the Far East. Both of them survived otherwise I wouldn't be here but remembering their friends that didn't was important to them and now to me. The children tonight made this year very special.

The performance contained some very moving poetry and songs from the First World War and Artistic Director, Hayley Roberts should be congratulated in getting this wonderful show together in such a short time. I'm sure this is something the children will remember for years to come.



