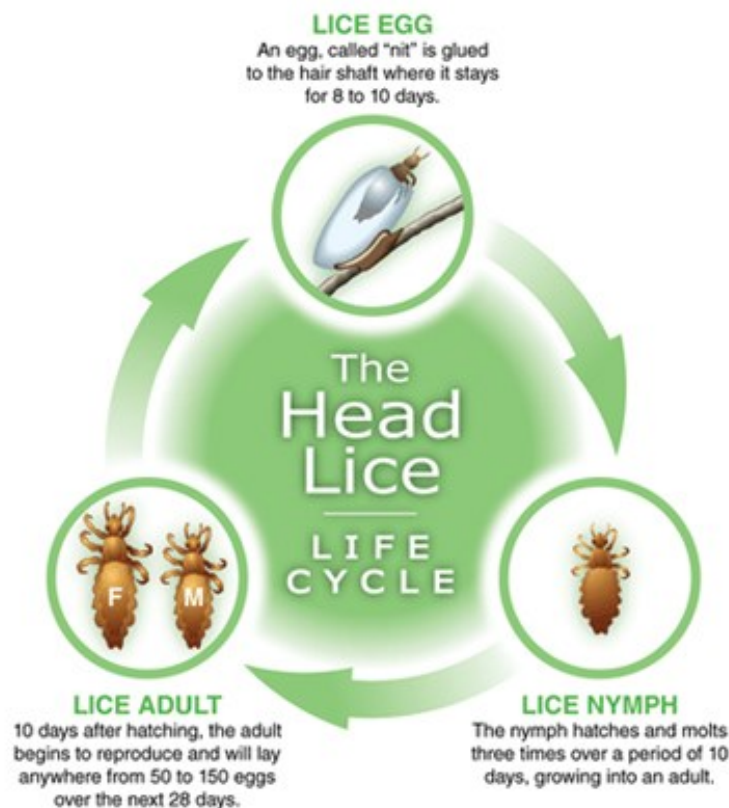
Parents:

There are still spaces in **Chess Club** with Mr Ryan on a Friday — These can be booked via your MCAS account under the Clubs section.

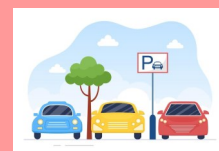
We also have spaces in **Gymnastics Club** on a Friday — These can be booked via the Premier Education Website.

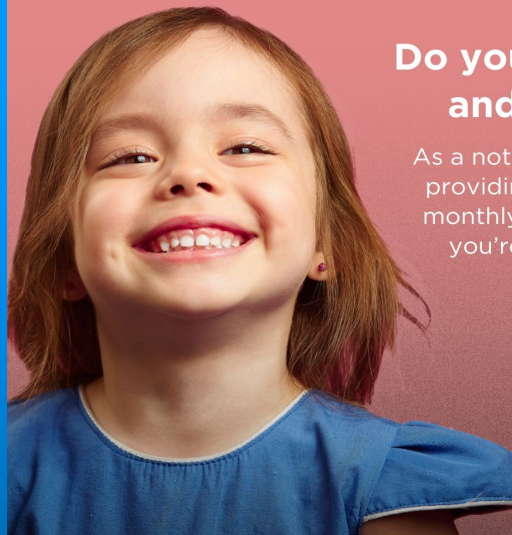
