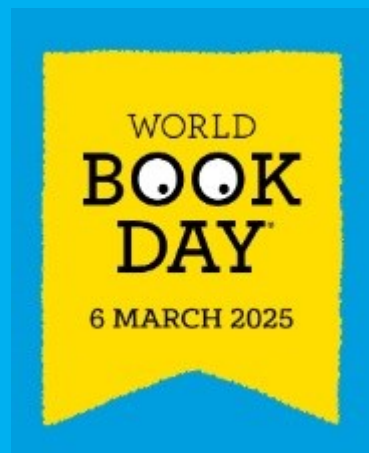
World Book Day - Thursday 6th March
