Young Voices 2025

Thank you for your response regarding the Young Voices event on the 12th February 2025.

As stated in the previous letter, we will travel to Sheffield by coach. Upon arrival, schools will register at the venue and will spend time rehearsing in the afternoon ready for the big performance in the evening. A more precise itinerary will be sent to you shortly before the event.

Each child is welcome to take up to 2 adults with them to watch the performance. The cost for each adult will be £24 per ticket plus an additional cost for the coach for both adults and child (we can be more specific about the coach cost once we know how many adults and children in total will be attending).

Children will need t-shirts for the event (£15). We have a tight schedule for making arrangements; tickets and T-shirts will need to be ordered by the 21st of October.

Last year the total cost per adult was approx £50 and per child was approx £40. Please note this is just a rough idea of what the costings will be this year.

All payments will be via **ParentPay** (we will confirm once payments go live). The T shirt payment of £15 will be required to be paid by the 21st October to secure your places. Unfortunately due to the nature of this trip, all costings will need to be paid in full regardless of attendance by Friday 6th December 2024

Please complete the Google form sent out by text to let us know whether your child wishes to take part and to place an order for tickets and t-shirts. This form will close on 14th October 2024.

If you agree to your child attending this trip you will be accepting that you understand the following:

- While the supervisory adults in charge of the group will take all responsible care of your child, neither they, nor West Norfolk Academies Trust, can necessarily be held liable in respect of loss or damage to property or injury suffered by your child arising out of the educational visit/journey, unless such loss, damage or injury results from the negligence of West Norfolk Academies Trust, its employees or official volunteers.
- Your child may receive medication as instructed and any emergency dental, medical or surgical treatment, including anaesthetic or blood transfusion, as considered necessary by medical authorities present.
- You are happy for your child to be transported by coach to and from this event (sharing with Clenchwaton and West Lynn Primary Schools) and you understand the extent and limitations of the insurance cover provided details of which are displayed in the front office of the school.
