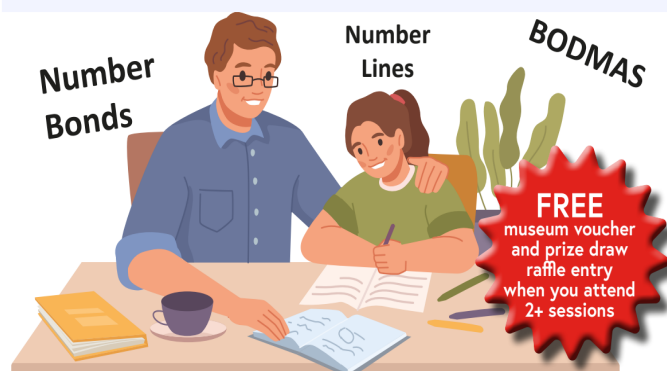
Being late after the registers close at 9.15am, is also marked as unauthorised and will go against your child's attendance.
