I loved POWER IN ME! Especially 'I got the power...p, p...power! I loved it! **Delilah**

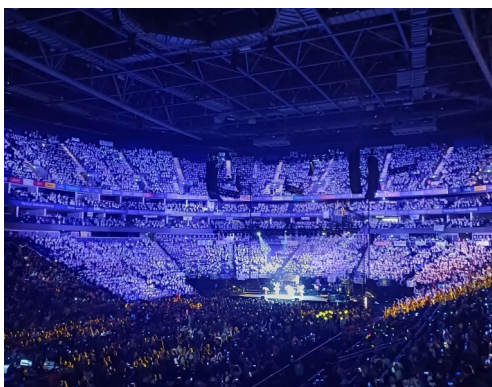


I loved the Power in Me and the Wicked medley! **Grace**

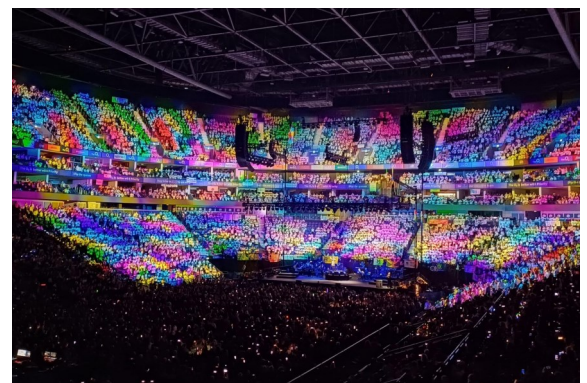
Young Voices was a really cool experience. We sang with 8,890 other children and it was nice seeing all of the colourful lights! I would like to go again. **Juliet**

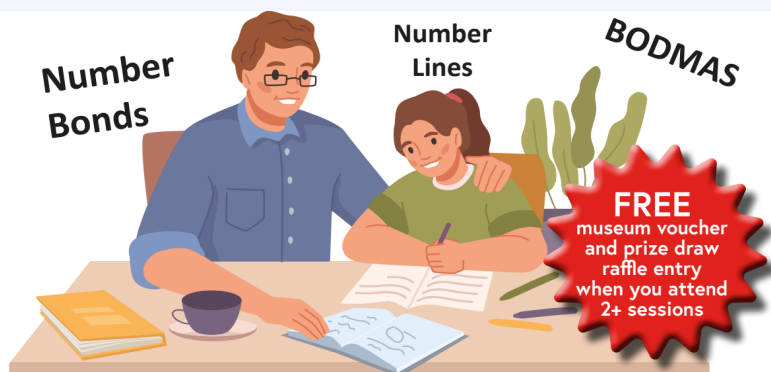
