# Year 6 Leavers' Hoodies

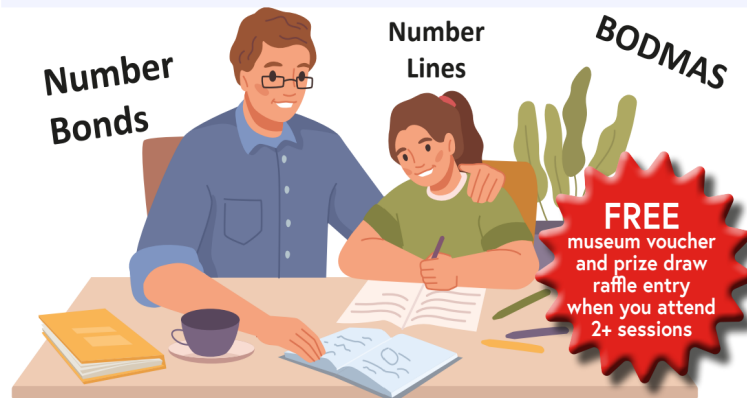
On the final day before the Christmas holidays, our Year 6's were presented with their Leavers' hoodies!
