Well done to Ruby, Neve and Annie from Year 5, for representing our school at the Primary Literary Event held last week at the Alive Corn Exchange.



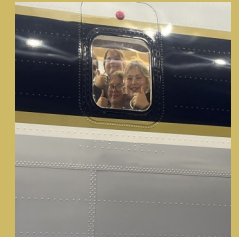

Year 6 Duxford Trip



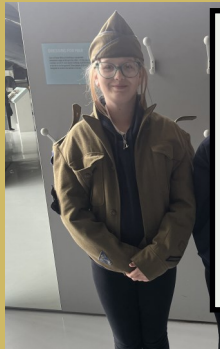
I liked Duxford because it had cool planes and they told us about the war.
